

## Diwali Celebration

Dear Parents,

Don Bosco Senior Secondary School Nerul, is conducting various competitions as a part of Diwali Celebration, for the students of Classes I to XII on Friday, 25th October, 2019.

### The competitions that will be conducted are as follows:

1. Toran making for the students of Red house
2. Diya decoration and arrangement for the students of Blue house
3. Lantern making for the students of Green house
4. Rangoli making for the students of Yellow house

### The competitions will be held in different groups:

- Classes I to IV class-wise individual competition
- Classes V and VI house-wise
- Classes VII and VIII house-wise
- Classes IX and X house-wise
- Classes XI and XII house-wise

### Rules for the competitions for Classes I to IV are as follows:

1. **Rangoli making:** Rangoli to be drawn on an A4 size paper and coloured.
2. **Lantern making:** Small lantern less than 15 cm in height.
  - Lantern has to be displayed with the help of a string.
3. **Toran making:** Size of the Toran should be less than 15 cm.
  - The decoration should be done on 15 cm string.
4. **Diya decoration and arrangement:** A Diya to be decorated with sequins and other decorative materials.
  - Wax candles to be used for lighting.



**Rules for the competitions for Classes V to XII are as follows:**

**Theme : Environment and Social values**

1. **Rangoli making:** Size of the rangoli should not be more than 2 square feet.

- Any medium can be used to make the rangoli - flowers, rangoli colours, etc.
- Rangoli has to be put on a Chart Paper.

2. **Lantern making:** Size of the lantern should be atleast  $1\frac{1}{2}$  feet

- Lantern has to be displayed with the help of a string.

3. **Toran making:** Toran should be 2 feet in length.

- The decoration should be done on  $2\frac{1}{2}$  feet string.

4. **Diya decoration and arrangement:**

- Arrangement of diyas should be within an area of  $1\frac{1}{2}$  square feet.
- Diyas should be painted and decorated with sequins and other decorative materials. Wax candles to be used for lighting.

Students as a part of festivities can bring home-made sweets for sharing in their respective classrooms.

Students are required to bring all the necessary materials for the activities.
